



## Wolf Conflict Mitigation Grant Application

Reimbursement for Wolf Conflict Mitigation, is available on a first-come, first-served basis until the total \$70,000 award to the Bookcliff, South Side and Mount Sopris Conservation District and Garfield County Extension by the Colorado Dept. of Ag. is distributed OR by June 30, 2025, whichever comes first.

Producers will be reimbursed for:

### **Carcass Management:**

- \$500 to bury dead piles (4 animal minimal) Less than 4 animals reimbursed at rate of \$150
- \$150 to haul to dump- per trip
- Up to \$2.07 a foot to install electric fence around a dead pile

Proof of carcass management is required below and will include landfill weigh sheet, photo of the carcass/carcasses, and photos of the burial process as applicable.

**Range Riding:** In event of wolf pressure on producer(s) help with a start-up fund to hire and train range rider(s)

Time sheets or proof of related expenses will be required.

**Record Keeping:** Reimburse 80% up to \$200 for software/apps to maintain livestock records

Invoices/Receipts will be required for record keeping software/apps

All reimbursements will be reimbursed at the discretion of the review committee. Producers will be reimbursed as quickly as possible but only after all information requested has been provided.
